An Overview of the Psalms

Torah Psalms – 1, 19, 119

5 Books of Psalms (corresponding to the 5 Books of the Law)

<u>Book 1</u>

Psalms 1-14

1 Wisdom – Blessed is the man who delights in the Torah of the LORD (God is good)

- 2 Royal "I have installed my king on Zion/You are my son" (God is sovereign)
 - 3-7 Laments (personal)
 - 3 "How many are my foes!" (family pain)
 - 4 "How long!" anger (enemies)
 - 5 Lying enemies (words)
 - 6 I'm broken, save me (sickness, sin)
 - 7 l'm innocent, vindicate me (injustice)
 - 8 Hymn How majestic your name/You crowned mankind with glory and honor, (creation/man)
 - 9-13 Laments (societal)
 - 9 Justice for the poor (acrostic)
 - 10 Justice for those who victimize the poor (acrostic)
 - 11 Foundations are being destroyed, "What can the righteous do?"
 - 12 The LORD will arise, his words are true
 - 13 "How long!"
- 14 Wisdom "The fool has said in his heart, 'There is no God'"

Psalms 15-24

15 Entrance – "Who may dwell in God's house?" (the moral person)

16 Trust – "The Lord is my portion and my cup, Your holy one will not see decay"

- 17 Lament "Keep me as the apple of your eye"
 - 18 David's song of Thanksgiving "I called up the LORD...and he saved me"
 - 19 Hymn God speaks/we respond "The heavens declare...the law is perfect" (creation/sky)
 - 20/21 Royal prayers before and after battle
- 22 Lament "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?" (the cross)
- 23 Trust "The Lord is my shepherd and host"
- 24 Entrance "Who may ascend the hill of the LORD?" (the King of Glory)

Psalms 25-34

25 Acrostic – "Teach me your ways"

26 Lament – "I'm innocent"

- 27 Trust "The Lord is my light/I am confident of this"
 - 28 Lament "Hear my cry!"
 - 29 Hymn Voice of the LORD over the waters/enthroned over the flood (creation/water)
 - 30 Thanksgiving "You've turned my mourning into dancing"
- 31 Trust "Into your hands I commit my spirit"
- 32 Penitence "You forgave the guilt of my sin"
- 33 Hymn "Sing to him a new song", 22 verses
- 34 Acrostic "Taste and see that the LORD is good"

Psalms 35-41

35 Betrayal – "those who hate me without reason"

36 Feast – "They feast on the abundance of your house"

37 Patience – "Trust in the Lord", an acrostic with two verses per letter (wisdom)

38 Pain – "There is no health in my bones"

- 39 Silence "I will guard my mouth with a muzzle...My hope is in you"
- 40 Obedience "He lifted me out of the slimy pit...put a new song in my mouth"
- 41 Judas "he who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me"

Book 2

Psalms of the Sons of Korah (8 here + 4 in Book 3 = 12)

- 42/43 Individual lament "When can I meet with God?" (God has abandoned me)
 - 44 Communal lament "You have led us like sheep to the slaughter" (God has abandoned us)
 - 45 Royal Wedding "the king is enthralled with you" (song of the King and his Bride)
 - 46 Communal trust "God is within her; she will not fall" (the King and his City)
- 47 Ascension "God has gone up with a shout!" (The King ascends his throne)

48 God dwells in Zion, his city - "Great is the Lord in the city of our God!"

Repentance:

49 Wisdom – "Rich fools will be shepherded by death...their graves will be their home" (Sons of Korah) 50 Communal repentance – "God comes to judge his people and He will not be silent" (Asaph) 51 Individual repentance – "Have mercy on me O God" (David)

David's Laments (based on his enemies)

52 Doeg the Edomite (who slaughtered priests) "I am like an olive tree in the house of God" 53 The Fool (Nabal?) "The fool says in his heart 'There is no god'" 54 the Ziphites (betrayed David) "He will return evil to my enemies" 55 a friend's betrayal (Absalom?) "But as for me I trust in you" = central verse 56 the Philistines "You've put my tears in a bottle" 57 Saul "Be exalted O God...Awake my soul and sing" 58 unjust judges "there is a God who judges the earth" 59 Saul "God in his steadfast love will meet me" 60 Edomites "With God we shall do valiantly" David's Prayers of Trust (61-64) 61 a strong tower against my foes 62 my soul finds rest in God alone 63 I thirst for God, I sing in the shadow of your wings 64 God shoots back at his enemies Corporate Hymns of Praise (65-68) 65 Thanksgiving for the harvest 66 Fire and Water (an Exodus hymn) 67 Missionary Prayer and Blessing 68 Cloud-Rider (Recalls the march from Mt Sinai to Mt Zion) Lament Turned to Testimony and Trust (69-71) 69 I've been poisoned, they're trying to kill me (the cross)

70-71 When I am old, do not forsake me

A Coronation Prayer (The Glory of the Messiah)

72 Royal Coronation (Solomon)

Book 3: Psalms for use in the Exile (Theme: Theodicy)

Asaphite collection: Psalms 73-83 (11 in Book 3 + Psalm 50 = 12)

- 73 Wisdom Why keep the covenant?
 - 74 Communal lament over the destruction of Jerusalem
 - 75 God humbles and exalts
 - 76 God will judge and be victorious in battle
 - 77 Individual lament
 - 78 Explanation of Israel's suffering (77 Hebrew verses longest and central psalm)
 - 79 Pay back blood for blood
 - 80 Israel is God's vine, a prayer to restore the vine
 - 81 Call to worship, listen and be satisfied with honey from the Rock
 - 82 The gods (rulers) of this world are judged for how they treated the weak
 - 83 Prayer for rescue and judgment on foreign oppressors (Midian)
- Prayers in exile: Psalms 84-89 (Sons of Korah, 4 here + 8 [Psalms 42-49] = 12)
 - 84 Individual prayer, longing for Zion, pilgrimage
 - 85 Communal prayer for renewal of God's mercies and a return from exile (Davidic)
 - 86 Individual prayer for mercy
 - 87 YHWH will establish Zion and the nations will be blessed through her
 - 88 Individual lament (darkness)
 - 89 Praise the God of creation and covenant, lament over Israel's unfaithfulness, appeal to God's faithfulness (Ethan the Ezrahite)

Book 4: Psalms 90-106 (Theme: The LORD Reigns!)

The Lord Reigns

- 90 Wisdom, man's mortality (Moses)
- 91 God's protection "In the shadow of the Almighty"
- 92 The righteous will flourish like a palm tree
- 93 God reigns over the waters
- 94 God will avenge
- 95 Invitation to worship and Warning
- 96 Holy Creator and Judge
- 97 Rejoice in his judgment
- 98 YHWH's coming to judge (Joy to the World!)
- 99 Holy, Holy, Holy
- 100 Invitation to worship

101 Royal (David's Coronation Oath, the King's character)

102 Individual Lament (prayer of an afflicted man)

- 103 The Love of God (David)
 - 104 Works of God in creation (the earth as a bountiful garden) (creation/earth)
 - 105 Historical God's faithfulness
 - 106 Historical Mankind's (Israel's) unfaithfulness
 - 107 Works of God in rescuing people in every situation
- 108 Love of God (Psalms 57 & 60 Davidic)
- 109 Individual Lament (David)

110 Royal (David's Coronation Oracle, the King's role: warrior and priest)

107 Call to praise God for his salvation in all circumstances

108-110 Davidic psalms

111-112 Call to praise (Praise the LORD/Fear the LORD), acrostic

- 113-118 Egyptian Hallel (for use during the festivals, primarily Passover)
 - 113 He raises the poor from the dust
 - 114 Exodus hymn
 - 115 Impotent idols
 - 116 Cup of salvation
 - 117 Universal praise
 - 118 Cornerstone
- 119 Torah (longest psalm, center of Book 5, meditation on the revelation of God)

120-134 Songs of Ascents (pilgrim songs for festival use)

- 120 Repentance, "Too long have I dwelt among those who hate peace"
- 121 Providence, "I lift up my eyes to the hills"
- 122 Worship, "I was glad when they said to me, Let us go to the house of the LORD"
- 123 Service, "As the eyes of a servant look to the hand of their master"
- 124 Help, "If the LORD had not been on our side"
- 125 Security, "As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people"
- 126 Joy, "Those who sow in tears will reap in joy"
- 127 Work, "Unless the LORD builds the house"
- 128 Happiness, "Your children will be like olive shoots around your table"
- 129 Perseverance, "The plowers plowed upon my back"
- 130 Hope, "My soul waits for the Lord, more than watchmen for the morning"
- 131 Humility, "I have calmed and quieted my soul"
- 132 Obedience, "The LORD swore to David a sure oath"
- 133 Community, "Behold how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity"
- 134 Blessing, "Bless the LORD"
- 135-136 Call to praise (Give thanks to the LORD for he is good)
- 137 Lament in exile "By the waters of Babylon we sat and wept"

138-145 Davidic psalms

138 Song of Praise, "May All Kings Praise You"

139 Search me

- 140 Rescue me
- 141 Rebuke me
- 142 Release me

143 Rescue me (penitential)

144 Royal Song of Praise (parallels Ps 18)

145 Royal Song to the Great King, acrostic

5 Psalms of Doxology 146-150, a climactic call for all things and all people to praise YHWH

- 146 My Soul (individual)
- 147 Jerusalem (community)
- 148 Heaven and Earth (creation)
- 149 Israel/Redeemed (saints)
- 150 Everything that has breath (everyone, everywhere, in every way)
